

HOW TO REPAIR A GATOR CLIP:

Welch suspenders are known for their strong, reliable gator clips, but at some point you may experience a clip coming apart from overuse or unexpected damage. These are easily repairable by following the steps below:



CLIP PARTS:



Loop



Back
with Top Slot & Side Holes



Center
with Gator Teeth,
Top & Side Wings



Front
with Side Wings

STEP 1:

Place the **Loop** over the top portion of the **Back** piece (Figure 1).

STEP 2:

Place the **Center** piece on top of the **Back** piece with the Gator teeth facing down, and insert the top wings into the top slot on the **Back** (Figure 2 & 3).



STEP 3:

Place the **Front** piece on top of the Center and Back pieces and insert the side wings on the **Front** into the side holes of the **Back**. The **Front** should be securely fastened to the **Back** holding the **Center** in place. (Figure 4)



STEP 4:

Bend the **Front** inward to close. Make sure the sides of the **Back** piece are not too tight so that the **Front** doesn't close (Figure 5).
